Actually I always had a doubt about the piece I have shown in Canada as I was miles away from the space and I did not have the possibility of displaying it the way I wanted.

If you agree with my proposal

(which may also give me a possibility of joining your team in manchester, which is closer to my country than canada) I may continue the communication with you, to the final desicion upon the new project, and find solutions for the financial possibilities, which would stay within the budget.
